Consider buying gift cards for your everyday purchases to places like Target, Wal-Mart, Amazon, Home Depot. When you buy the ecards they are emailed to you within minutes to be pulled up on your phone (or printed) and used at the store.

Here is how you can use the app to start making your ecard purchases.

Download the RaiseRight by ShopWithScrip app (it has 2 hearts intertwining)

Create an account (Enrollment Code: 8AE3LA7161921)

Start shopping!! This flyer gives you more info on how you will pay and to set up your payment accounts.
